

## EXPEDITION ITINERARY - CLIMBING TWEEN TOUR

### **Sunday, June 9**

- Meet participants at Sugar House Park ([Sugar Beet Pavilion](#), SE corner of the park), at 1:00. Orientation, activities, and equipment review.
- Transport group 20 miles to [Spruces](#) Campground in Big Cottonwood Canyon, a government-run campsite in [Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest](#). The campsite is equipped with flushing toilets and running water.
- Participants and [staff](#) set up camp, prepare dinner using propane camp stove, start a campfire in the designated fire pit, and play games and activities in campground.
- Sleep in tents with staff members in adjacent tents.

### **Monday, June 10 - Thursday, June 13**

- Breakfast and dinner will be at campsite using propane camp stove. Lunch will be packed and will be eaten at the climbing site.
- Group will be transported to and from climbing sites in Big Cottonwood or Little Cottonwood Canyon. Climbing supervision and instruction led by [Utah Mountain Adventures](#), a licensed guiding service.
- Evenings at the campsite may include games and activities, campfire in the designated fire pit, and/or hiking in or from the campground.

### **Friday, June 14**

- Prepare breakfast using propane camp stove. Lunch will also be at the campsite.
- Pack up all supplies, gear, and personal items.
- Go for a day hike from the campground.
- Return to Sugar House Park (Sugar Beet Pavilion, SE corner of the park), by 3:00. Pick up between 3:30 - 4:00.

### **Sunday, June 16**

- Meet participants at Sugar House Park ([Sugar Beet Pavilion](#), SE corner of the park), at 1:00. Orientation, activities, and equipment review.
- Transport group 40 miles to [Granite Flat campground](#) in American Fork Canyon, a government-run campsite in [Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest](#). The campsite is equipped with vault toilets, but no running water. Water will be provided by staff.
- At Granite Flat campground, participants and staff set up camp, prepare dinner using propane or [Whisperlite](#) stoves, start a campfire in the designated fire pit, and play games and activities in the campground.
- Sleep in tents with staff members in adjacent tents.

### **Monday, June 17**

- All meals at the campsite.
- Wilderness 101 skills and preparation for backpacking expedition

### **Tuesday, June 18**

- Begin backpacking excursion to [Silver Lake and Silver Glance](#).

### **Wednesday, June 19**

- Explore high mountain lakes in upper American Fork Canyon.

### **Sunday, June 23**

- Meet participants at Sugar House Park ([Sugar Beet Pavilion](#), SE corner of the park), at 1:00. Orientation, activities, and equipment review.
- Transport group 175 miles to Vernal, UT. Camp at [Vernal KOA](#), a privately-owned and operated developed campground in town. The campground is equipped with flushing toilets and running water.
- Transport 1 mile to and from [OARS](#)/Don Hatch Expeditions Vernal headquarters for pre-trip orientation in the evening.
- At [KOA](#), participants and staff set up camp, prepare dinner using propane camp stoves, start a campfire in the designated fire pit, play games and activities in the campground.
- Sleep in tents with staff members in adjacent tents.

### **Monday, June 24**

- Breakfast at the campsite then transport to [OARS](#)/Don Hatch Expeditions headquarters for the 3-day paddling expedition in [Gates of Lodore on Green River](#).
- [OARS](#) shuttles participants 40 miles from Vernal to drop in the location at [Flaming Gorge Dam Visitor Center](#).
